A strategic crossroad

- Because of its position on the Danube, Vukovar was always a strategic military and trade point.
- It was shaped by the Ottoman Empire and later the Austro-Hungarian Empire, which gave the city its unique Baroque architecture (Palaces, the Eltz Manor and arched walkways).
- its position made it a frontline during various conflicts, most notably in the 1990s, shaping the city's identity as a symbol of courage and survival.
- Known globally for its heroic defense in the 1990s, today, the Water Tower stands as a world-famous symbol of victory and new life.

People & Multiculturalism

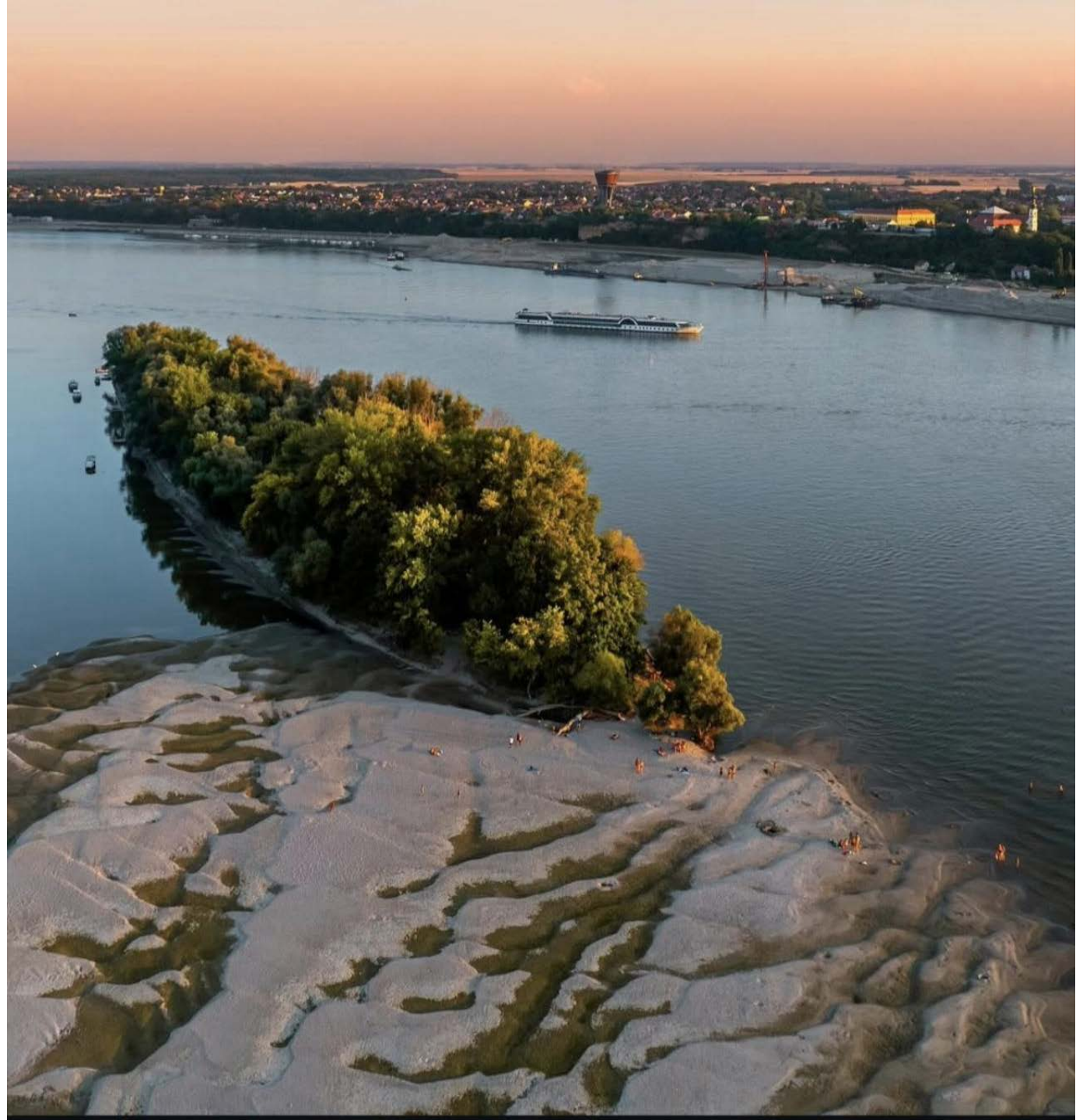
- Vukovar is famous for its multiculturalism. For centuries, Croats, Serbs, Germans, Hungarians, Ukrainians and others have lived side-by-side.
- This mix of cultures is reflected in the city's many churches, traditional costumes and local dialects.
- Vukovar is a city where many languages are spoken, but everyone understands the language of hospitality. Vukovar is known for Slavonian hospitality - where every guest is treated like family and nobody leaves with an empty stomach!

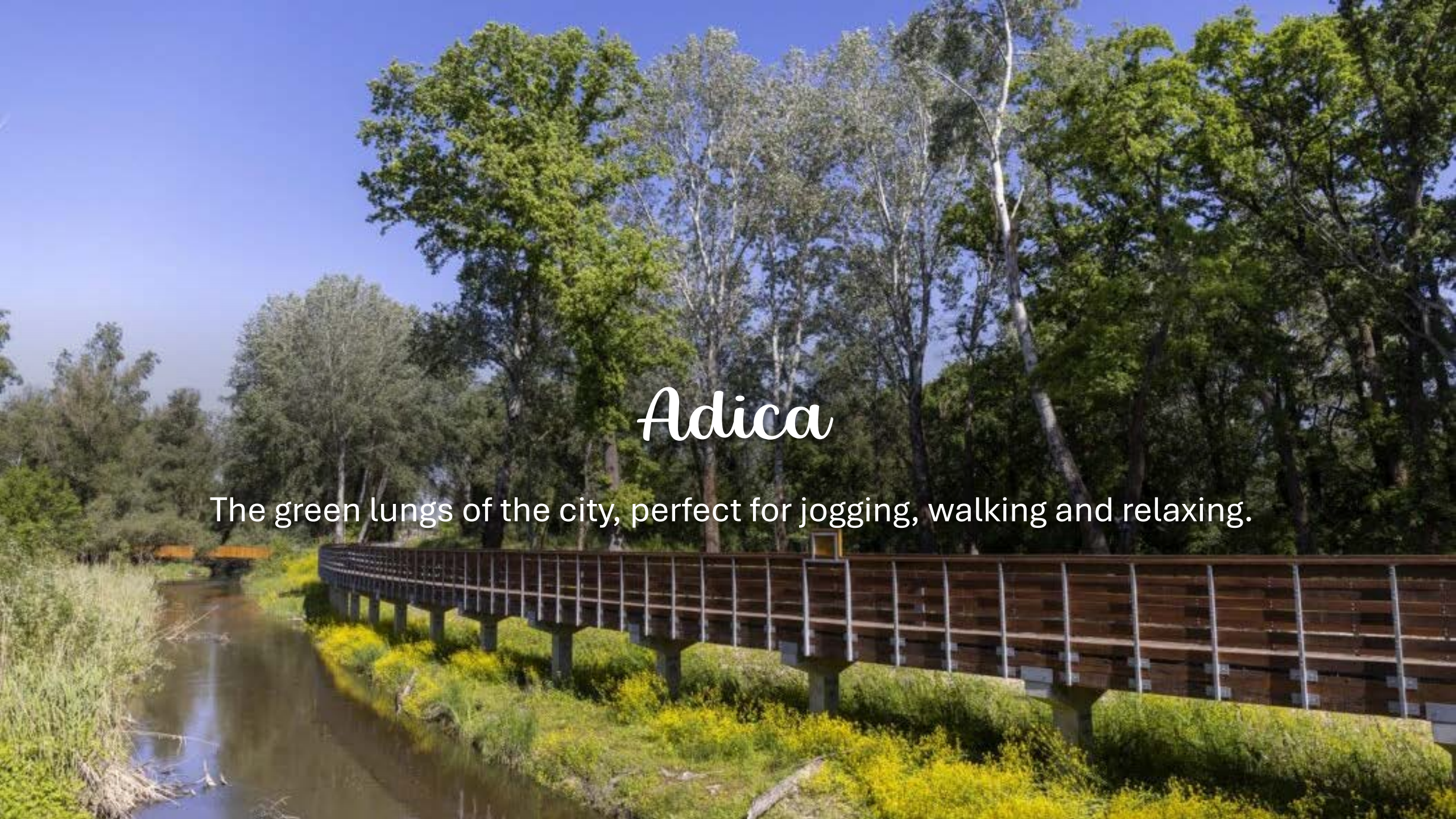

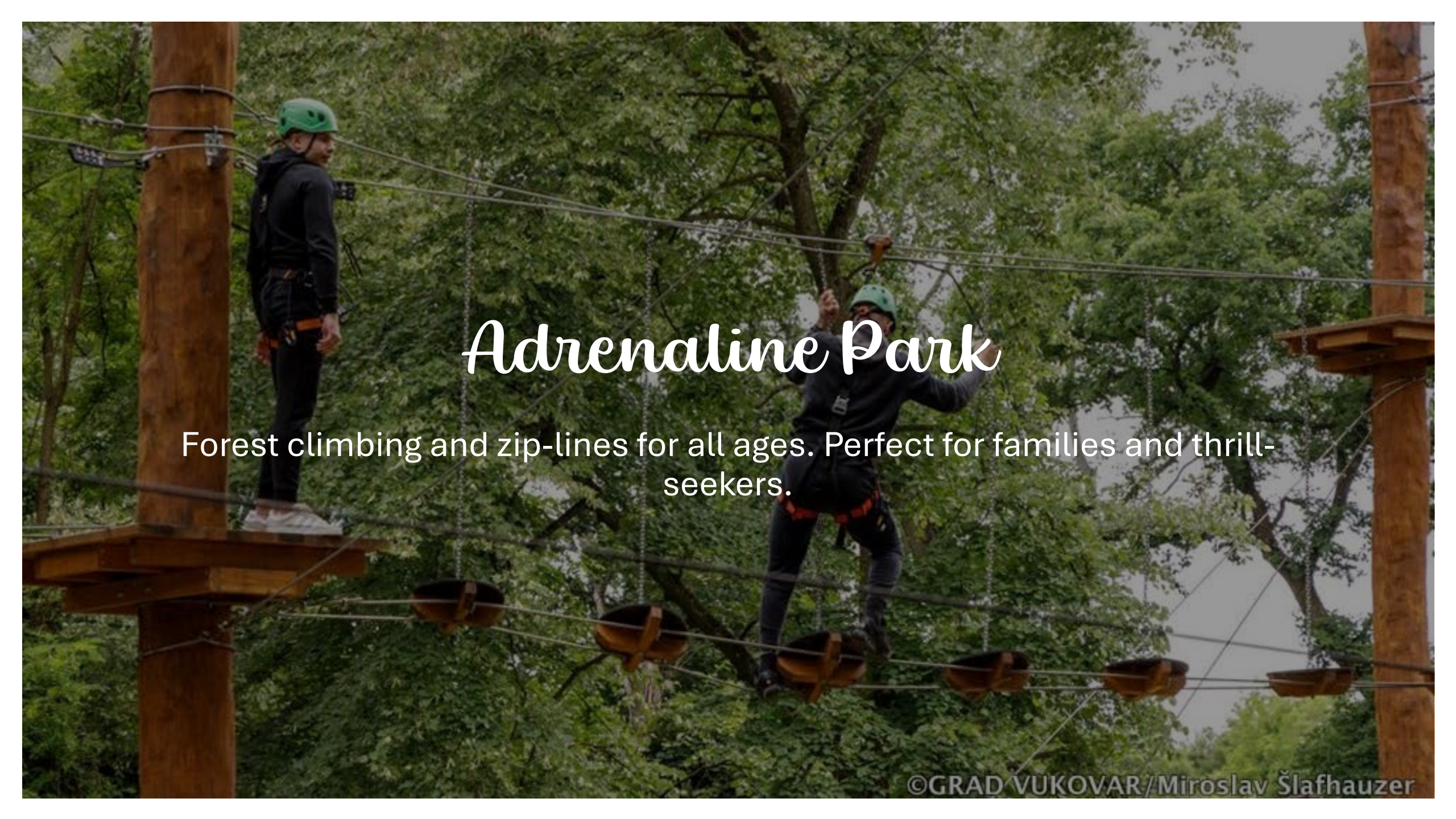
Adica

The green lungs of the city, perfect for jogging, walking and relaxing.



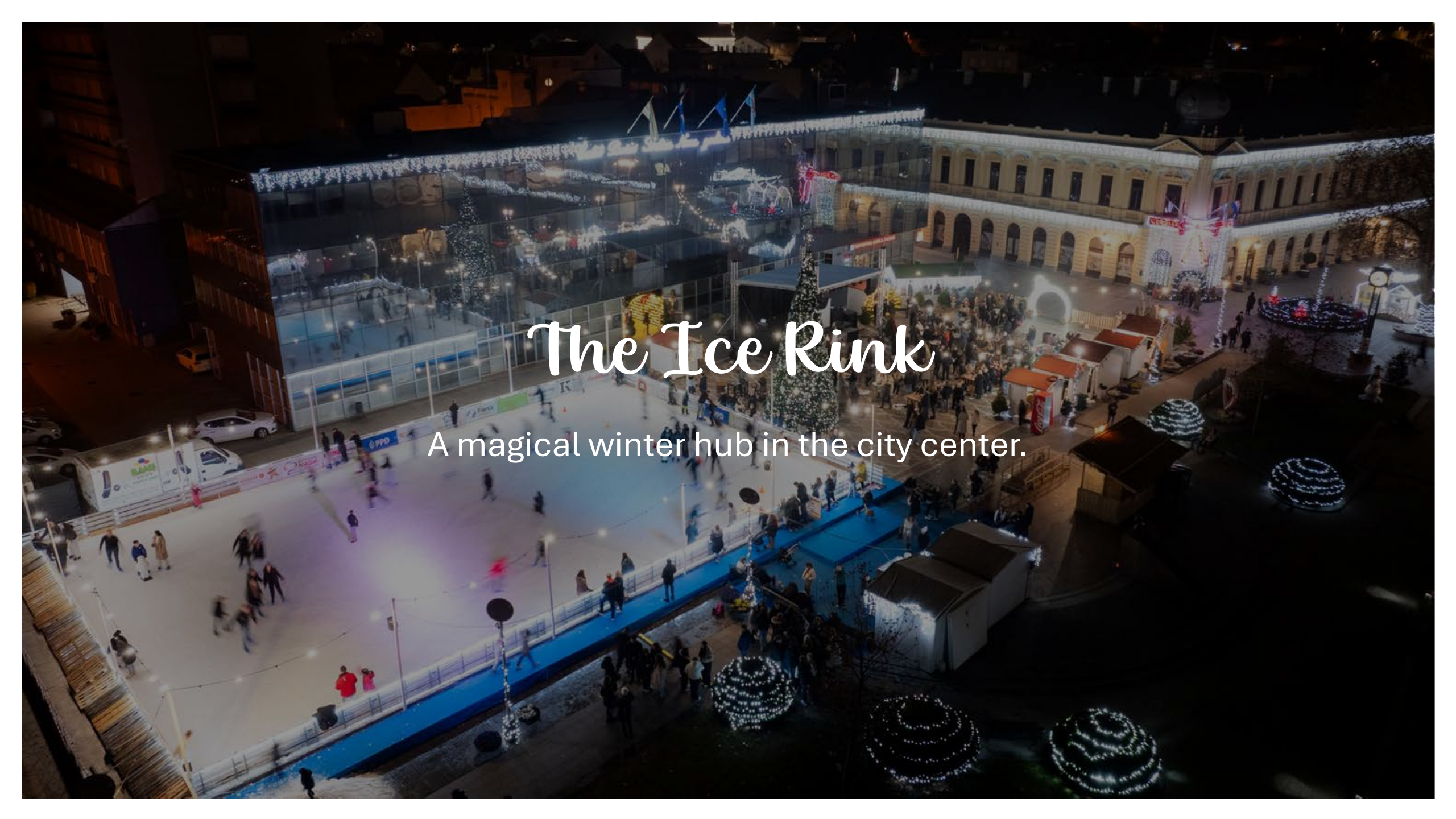
Swimming pools

A magical winter hub in the city center.



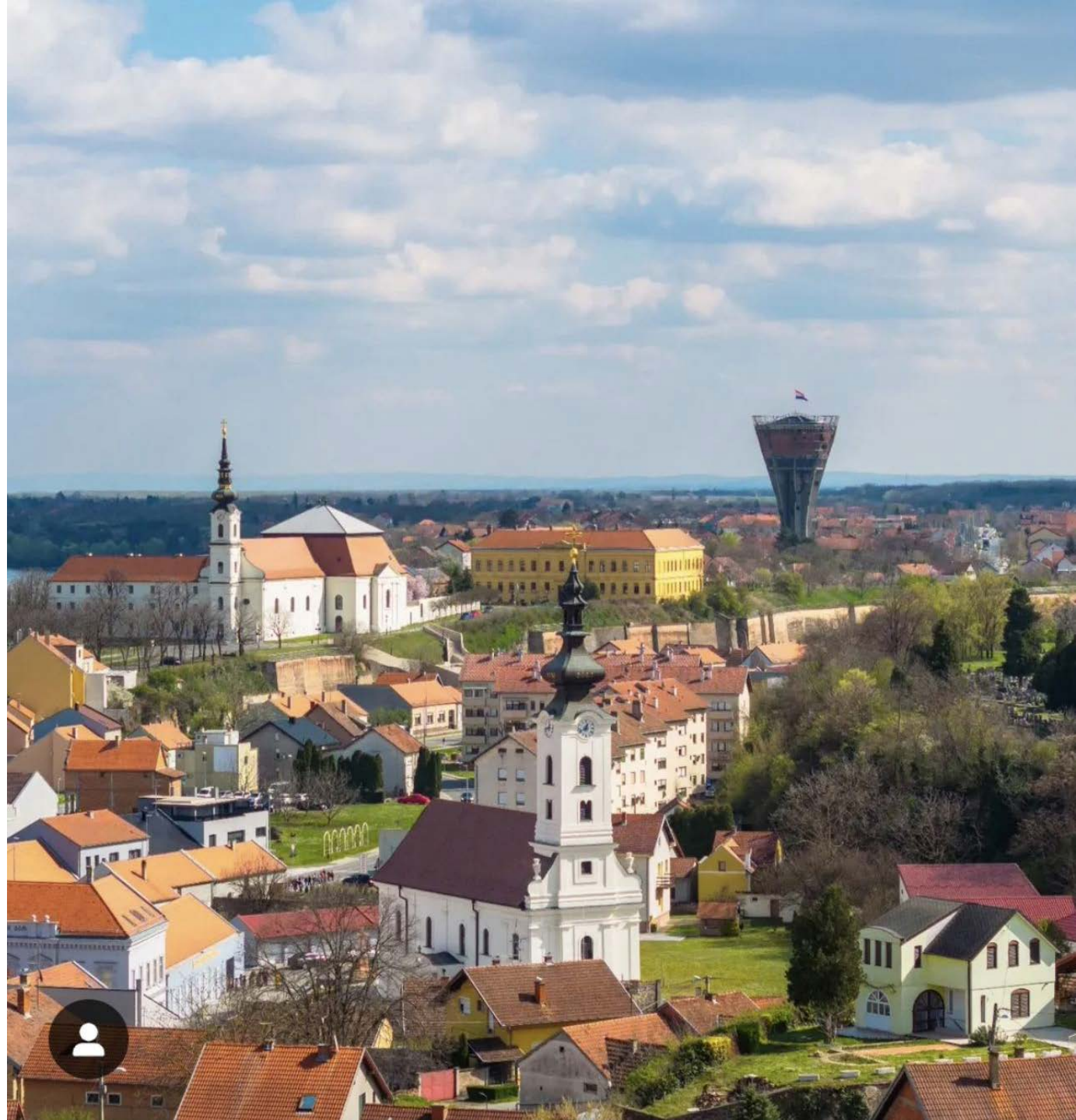
Vukovar today - Life, Fun, and Recreation

Dragutin Tadijanović Elementary School

Our School

- **Dragutin Tadijanović Elementary School** is located in Vukovar, a town of rich history and cultural heritage.
- The school was founded in 1960 with the original name being **Ivo Lola Ribar Elementary School**, and has from its conception been an important place for education and upbringing.



A New Beginning

- During the **Homeland War in 1991**, Vukovar suffered much destruction, which also affected the school's operation.
- After the **peaceful reintegration of the Croatian Danube region in 1997**, school life started recuperating, students and teachers returning, and the community rebuilding.
- Today, classes at our school are organized in **both Croatian and Serbian languages**, establishing our school at the forefront of **mutual respect, tolerance, and coexistence**.

Name Changes

- Today, our school bears the name of a famous Croatian poet, **Dragutin Tadijanović**.
- In 2005, he **personally agreed** to allow for our school to bear his name, and **in 2007 this officially came into effect**.
- The name of Dragutin Tadijanović symbolizes our school's connection with **Croatian literature, culture, and tradition**.



School Structure

- Our school is made up of the following:
 - Dragutin Tadijanović Elementary School (220 students) – main building
 - Elementary Music School (189 students)
 - Branch school Lužac (8 students)
 - Branch school Bogdanovci (24 students)
 - Dance and ballet school (30 students)
- Number of students: 471
- Number of employees: 105
- Classes take place on several separate locations.
- Many classes include special needs students with individualized education plans (learning disabilities, behavioral disorders) + Special Needs Class (2 students)

Students also participate in humanitarian, cultural and educational projects.



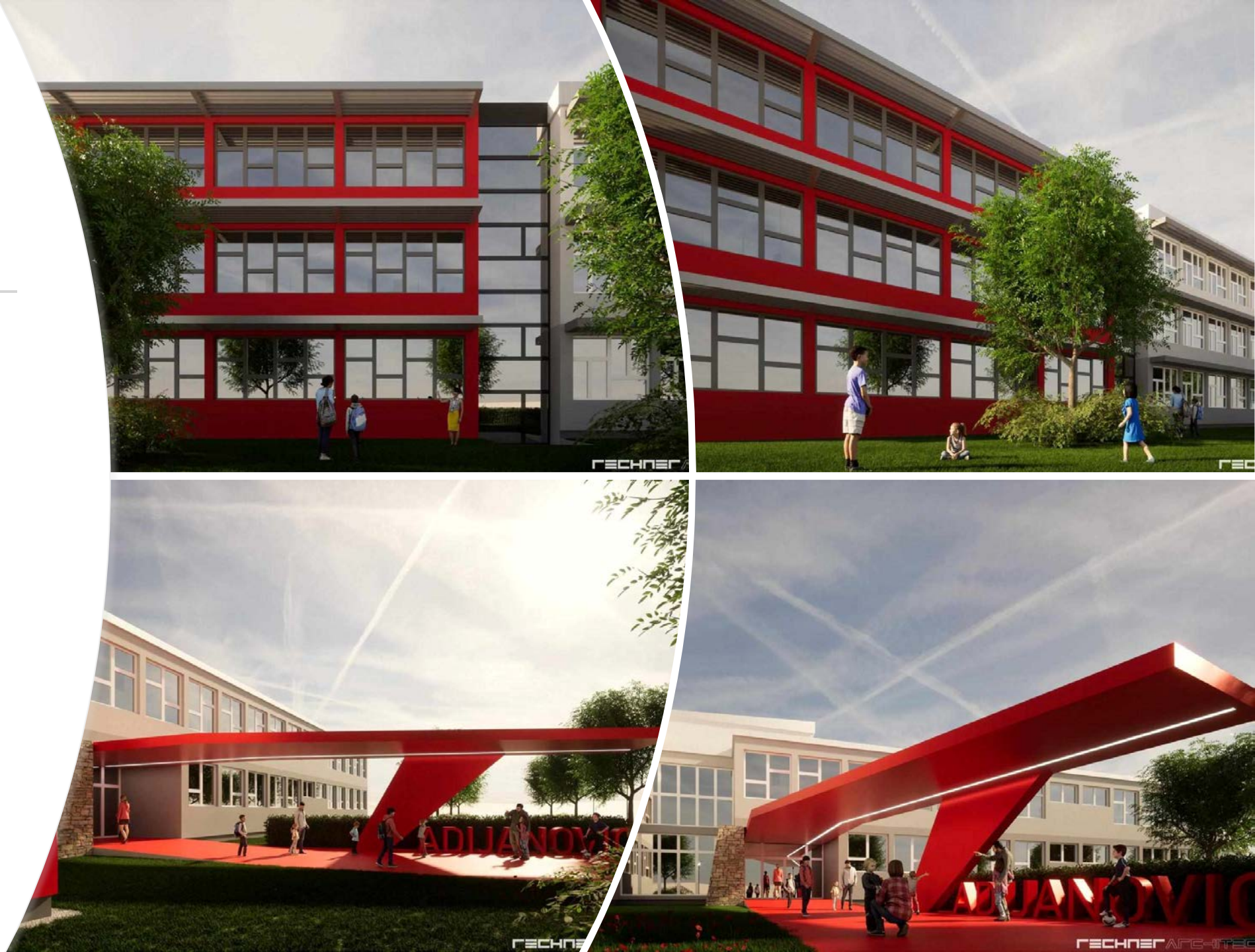
E-Schools

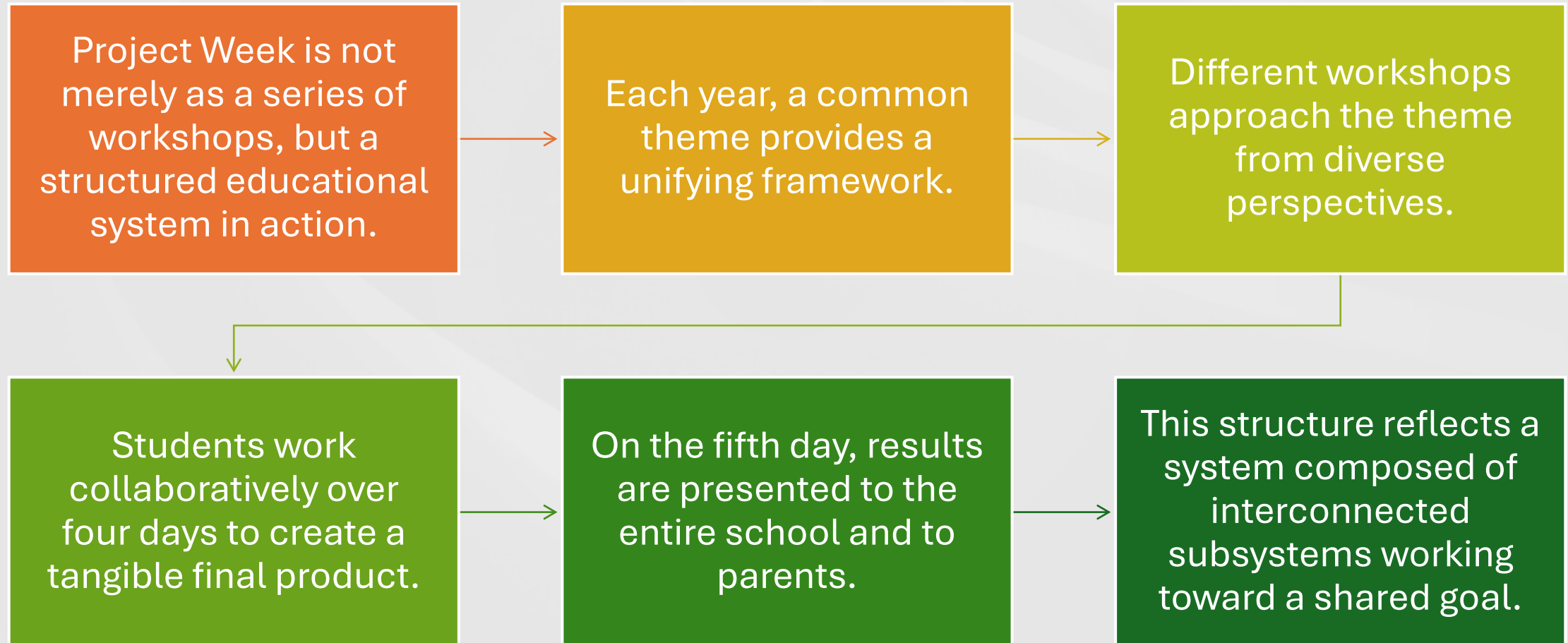


SYSTEMS THINKING

- Systems thinking is an approach that views phenomena as parts of a larger whole rather than as isolated elements. It emphasizes relationships, interactions, interdependence, feedback loops, and long-term effects within a system.
- In education, this means understanding the school as a system in which students, teachers, curriculum, parents, values, and the wider community continuously influence one another.



Project Week as a Systemic Educational Model



Structure of the System: Process and Interconnection

Theme Selection – Establishes the value-based and curricular framework.

Workshop Design – Different perspectives exploring the same central theme.

Collaborative Work – Teachers and students work together.

Creation of Final Products – Concrete outcomes of collective learning.

Public Presentation – Feedback from peers, teachers, and parents.

Interdisciplinarity and Holistic Understanding



Complex social and educational challenges are rarely linear. Through thematic exploration:



One workshop may approach the topic scientifically.



Another may examine social dimensions.



A third may focus on artistic expression.

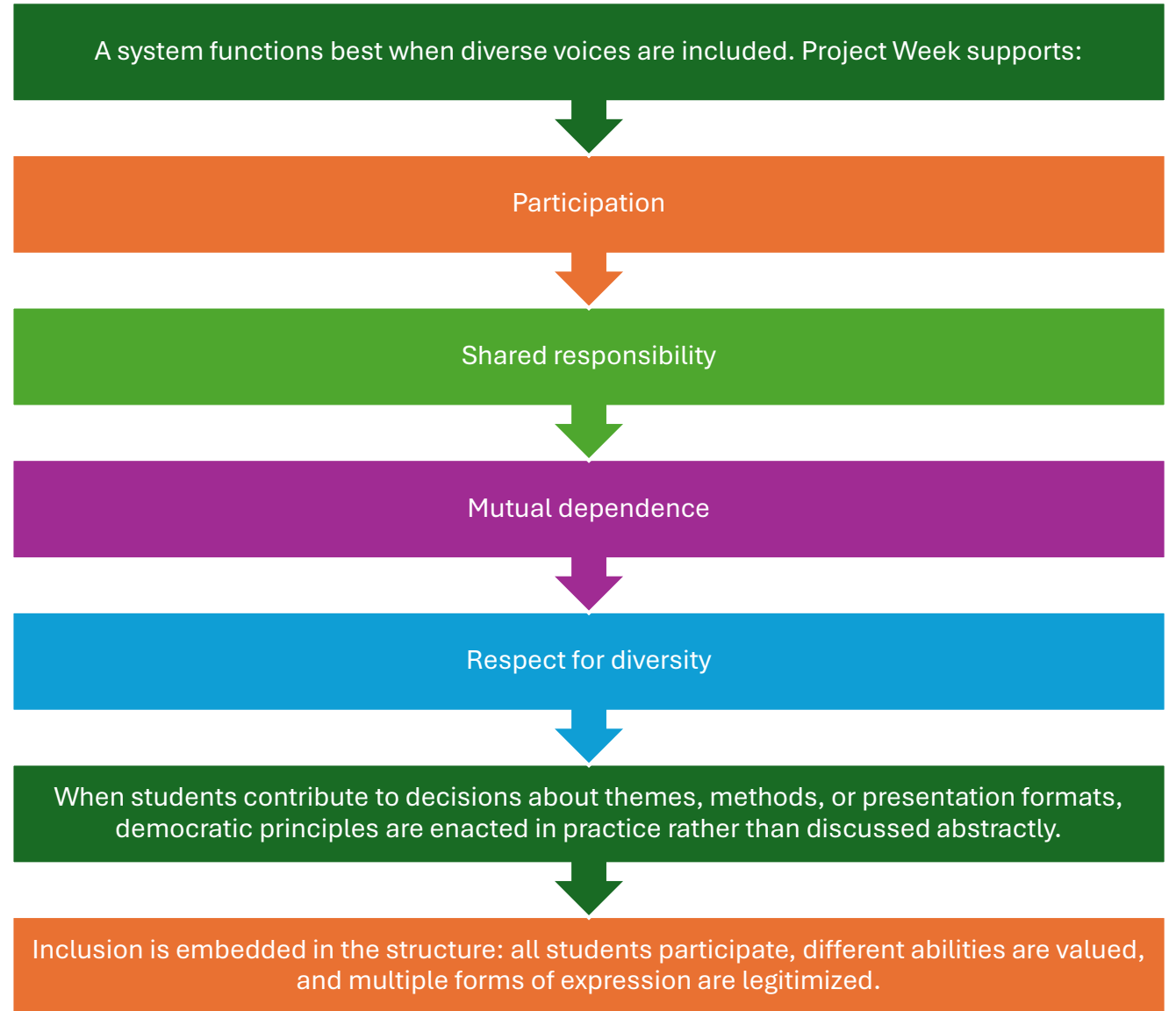


A fourth may develop technical or practical solutions.



Students learn to see issues as interconnected systems rather than isolated problems. This fosters critical thinking and long-term understanding.

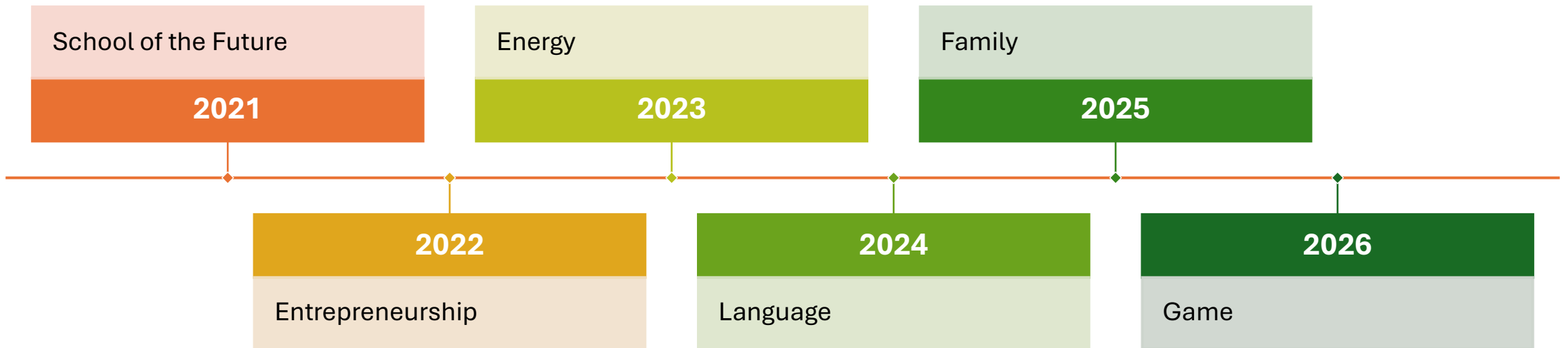


School as a Living System

Project Week represents a micro-model of the school as a living system:

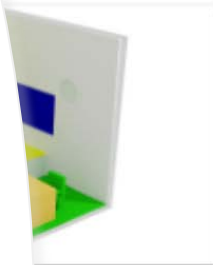
- Shared vision (annual theme)

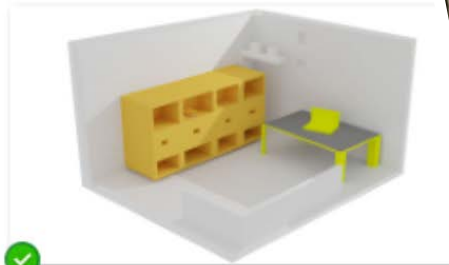

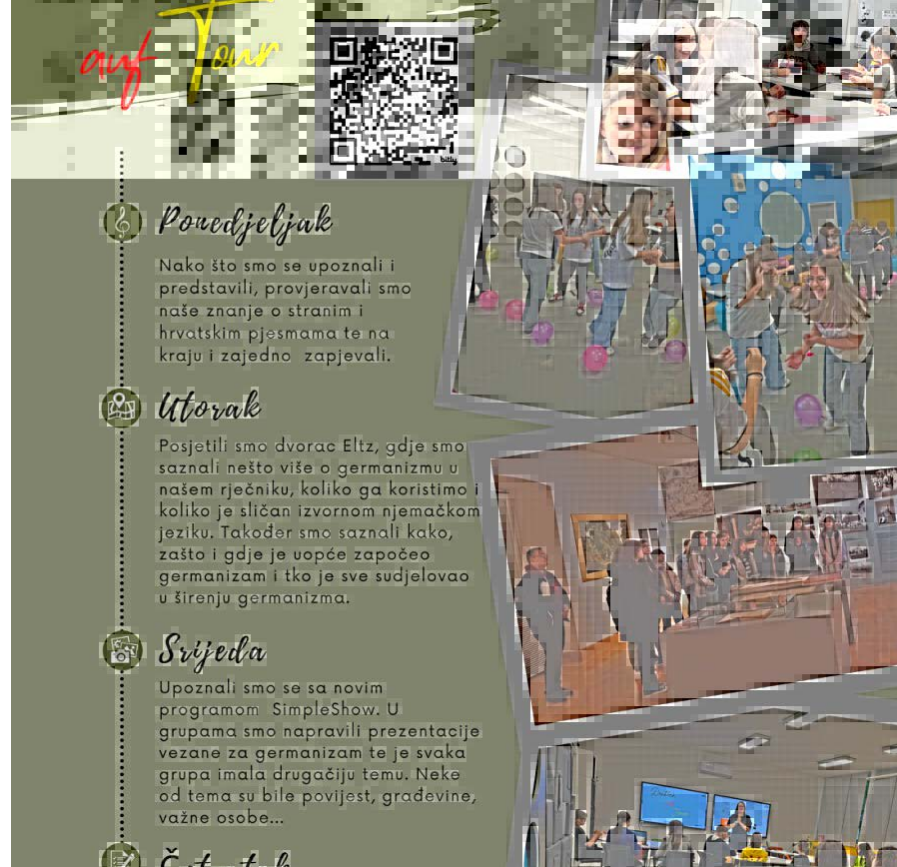
